4. NO. Any load that has lightweight items or something that might fly away needs to be tarped. Concrete, asphalt, heavier kiln-dried lumber loads and clean cover are an exception.
5. All loose or lightweight items must be bagged before coming to the landfill.
6. Asphalt, Asphalt Shingles, Drywall, Cardboard, Kiln-Dried Lumber, Scrub & Brush, Yard & Garden, Concrete.
7. Paints, Oils, Chemicals, Electronics, Food Waste, Light Bulbs.
8. 4km East of Exshaw.
9. Boulder Crescent Recycling Depot in Canmore.
10. Approximately 70% is diverted to recycling.
