STAYING SAFE AT FRANCIS COOKE

Safety in the landfill is a responsibility that we take very seriously. The Francis Cooke Regional Class III Landfill and Resource Recovery Center (FCRL) is an industrial worksite with continuous heavy equipment, pedestrian and other traffic. Here are a few safety tips to follow while visiting the landfill.

Obey the Speed Limit

Please respect the posted speed limit of 15 km/h. The landfill is a working industrial site and speeding puts everyone at risk.

No Smoking

The Francis Cooke facility has a no smoking policy. Smouldering material of any kind is not accepted due to the risk of fire.

Cell Phone Use

In Alberta, it's against the law to use your cell phone while driving. We have lots of room to pull over and park while using your devices.

No Scavenging

We have a strict no scavenging policy. Scavenging creates unnecessary danger and risk to your personal health and safety.

Children and Pets

Keep children and pets inside your vehicle at all times.

Be Aware

Please stay within 20 feet of your vehicle and be aware of the location of heavy equipment and other vehicles at all times.

Wear Personal Protective Equipment

While personal protective equipment (PPE) is not required to be worn by customers, it is suggested that work gloves and a sturdy shoe or boot be worn (no flip flops or high heels). Safety glasses should be worn especially on windy days.

Respect for Others

Abusive verbal or physical behaviour against landfill employees or other clients will not be tolerated.
