ACCEPTED MATERIALS: The Francis Cooke Landfill is a "Class III" (inert, dry waste) facility and cannot accept many materials that may be acceptable in other landfills. For example, no liquids, food, kitchen garbage, or hazardous substances are accepted. A surcharge of up to \$100.00 may be applied to loads tipped with uncontained litter or illegal items. Other charges may apply to illegally tipped materials if special handling is required.

To avoid extra charges, refer to our lists of **ILLEGAL**, **UNACCEPTABLE** and **EASILY RECOVERABLE** items.

LOAD REFUSAL: Loads with uncontained litter are refused when average wind exceeds 15 kilometers per hour. Check the current wind conditions at BVWaste.ca
